But he said to me, "My grace is enough for you. When you are weak, my power is made perfect in you." So I am very happy to brag about my weakness. Then Christ's power can live in me. 2 Corinthians 12:9

Do you know God favors you? Not because you are the most beautiful; not because you are the smartest; not because you have lots of talents; not because you do many good deeds—though all of these characteristics may be abundant in your life!


